

**BREAKSPEAR RIDING CLUB
RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. All classes will be judged under BD Rules.
2. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of any events to which these rules apply nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accept any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury, or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
3. Entries will be strictly limited and will be taken on a "first come, first served" basis.
4. Correct riding attire to be worn at all times when riding. Riding hats to conform to current BHS Riding Clubs regulations i.e. EN1384, PAS015.
5. Boots/bandages allowed for working in, but not during competition. No martingales. No grackle nosebands. No running/draw/side-reins. No bit guards. Snaffle bridles only (with the exception of the Elementary /Medium Tests)
6. In the event of cancellation of the show, entry fees will be returned, less £1.00 per competitor, to cover administration expenses.
7. **NO LUNGING BY COMPETITORS IS PERMITTED.**
8. **PRIZES** – Rosettes and any other prizes according to entries.
9. **WITHDRAWALS** – telephoned to the Secretary before the close of entries will receive a 50% refund. No refund under other circumstances.
10. **PARKING – NO HORSES TO BE LEFT UNATTENDED TIED OUTSIDE BOXES / TRAILERS.** Priority will be given to horse boxes; spectators' cars may be unable to park.
11. **IMPORTANT NOTE** – It is a prerequisite of Coltspring School of Riding that the horse parking area is left free of hay, straw and droppings. PLEASE CLEAR UP YOUR SPACE BEFORE YOU LEAVE.

Chiltern & Thames Rider Winter Dressage Membership is required:

Riders must be Chiltern & Thames Rider Members for the 2011/12 Winter Season before competing in a qualifying class.

Members should enter their membership number on the entry form at qualifying shows before competing in the class. Membership costs £12.00 online and £15.00 over the phone and lasts for the Winter Dressage Season.

(For Qualifying Shows between 15 October 2011 and 1 April 2012).

Classes are as follows:

INTRO

- Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the Championships.

Qualifying classes can be BD Intro A or B. They must not have won a Preliminary class, affiliated or unaffiliated before the date of qualification.

The best Junior also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved (14 years and under by 15 April 2012) Horses/ponies of any height.

PRELIMINARY

- Preliminary Restricted Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

The best Junior also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved (14 years and under by 15 April 2012) Horses/ponies of any height.

- Preliminary For horse and rider combinations who may have competed BD dressage but have no BD points.

The best Junior also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved (14 years and under by 15 April 2012). Horses/ponies of any height.

NOVICE

- Novice Restricted Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the Championships.

The best Junior also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved (14 years and under by 15 April 2012). Horses/ponies of any height.

- Novice For horse and rider combinations who may have gained points at novice level, but not higher.

The best Junior also qualifies as long as 58% is achieved. (14 years and under by 15 April 2012). Horses/ponies of any height.

Please note: Horse and rider combinations are not allowed to enter both the Restricted and Non Restricted sections at the Final.



ELEMENTARY

- Elementary Open : Open to all except horse and riders who are competing in the restricted sections.

MEDIUM

- Medium Open : Open to all except horse and riders who are competing in the restricted sections.

Restrictions apply to the date of the final, not the date of qualification. If a horse and rider qualifies at a lower level and then competes out of the class restrictions, they must enter a class that they are eligible for at the final.

Please Note Changes To The Restricted Classes: NEITHER Horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the Championships.

1st and 2nd place in each class qualifies. At least 58% must be achieved by all qualifiers. If the winner and second placed have already qualified, the qualification goes down the line to the next best tests, but those tests must be at least 58%. The qualification can go no further down than 5th place. *The Best Junior also qualifies.

Please note:

- It is the horse and rider combination that qualifies.
- No horse or rider substitutions will be allowed at the final.
- Horses and ponies may be ridden by two riders on the day , but both riders must be CTR members and only consecutive classes may be entered e.g. Preliminary and Novice.
- No horse may enter more than three classes at the Championships.
